

## Munster Region Connolly's Red Mill 1.35m Grand Prix League 2024

- Leading Rider / Horse Combination Prize 1<sup>st</sup>. €1,800 2<sup>nd</sup>. €500
- Young Rider Prize €200 to Leading Young Rider (21 YR), in the League
- Only one Grand Prix Class in the League in the Region on any one day.
- First round Entries to close at 4pm on the day before. Later entries up to 5pm with increase of €20.00 per entry.
- Prize Fund A Minimum of €2,000 1.35m per leg with Eight Prizes and Entry Fee of €35
- Prize Fund €2000. 1<sup>st</sup> €600, 2<sup>nd</sup> €400, 3<sup>rd</sup> €267, 4<sup>th</sup> 178, 5<sup>th</sup> €147, 6<sup>th</sup> €98, 7<sup>th</sup> €66, 8<sup>th</sup> €44.
- Rider must be properly attired in correct Jacket (including in competition) & be present for Prize Giving (1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>) unless excused by the Ground Jury. (Failure will result in forfeiture of prize money.)
- Entries on SJI Live
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE 5PM Cut OFF
- Horses must jump in the sequence as drawn per SJIlive. (This is for livestreaming)
- Any rider with multiple rides who brings an animal forward in sequence ahead of his/her given sequence will be eliminated from the Prize Money and League Points, awarded on the day, for either animal in the class.
- Only competitors that are on SJIlive are permitted to jump. Anyone who is not this list and entries the arena will be ELIMINATED by the judge for the day. You are not cover by insurance.
- A rider may substitute a Horse with permission from the Ground Jury **BUT** cannot change a RIDER.
- Horses that are placed in any 1.50m competition or Premier Horse League are NOT eligible for League Point but may jump for prize money.
- To be ELIGIBLE for Leading Rider Prize, those in contention must compete in the Final unless Medical or Veterinary Certificates received before the Final Starts.
- In the case of equal points after the Final the HIGHEST Placed Rider/Horse combination will be deemed the Leading Rider
- Points will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> 10pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 8pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 7pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 6pts -5<sup>th</sup> 5pts, 6<sup>th</sup> 4pts, 7<sup>th</sup> 3 pts and 8<sup>th</sup> 2pts. Points awarded to Rider/Horse Combination.
- Competitions must start on time, not later than 3pm, and rider must adhere to times on SJI Live.
- 2 Minute Rule between Riders entering the Arena will apply, for the first round.
- If the arena is empty for more than 20mins the Judges are required to close the class
- We recommend you have four Judges and one to be Senior National level.
- A person competent in call up procedures should be in the pocket.
- A cash bonus will be given to the best Three SEVEN-year-olds in the class. Must Jump Two clear rounds.
- A separate league table will apply for the subgroup (7 yr. olds) with the following points: 3 points for a double Clear round 2 points for one clear round and if faults in the first round you will get 1 point for appearance.
- Venue for the Final TBA
- Prize fund for the Final €3000.
- League Table will be available on the SJI and Munster website and on Facebook.
- Rules as per National Grand Prix re Judges and Course Designers.

## Munster Region Sweet Oak Farm 1.25m League 2024

- Competition will be run as a Modified TWO Phase
- > Only one Munster 1.25 Class in the Region on any one day
- Entry Fee €25.00
- First round Entries to close at 4pm on the day before. Later entries up to 5pm with increase of €20.00 per entry.
- Prize Fund: A Minimum of €500 at each leg of the league 1<sup>st</sup> €157, 2<sup>nd</sup> €105, 3<sup>rd</sup> 71, 4<sup>th</sup> €57, 5<sup>th</sup> €48, 6<sup>th</sup> 37
- Rider must be properly attired in correct Jacket (including in competition) & be present for Prize Giving (1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>) unless excused by the Ground Jury. (Failure will result in forfeiture of prize money.)
- Entries on SJI Live
- > NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED after the 5PM cut off.
- > We recommend there to be a Minimum of 13 fences.
- All competitors will be entitled to two rounds irrelevant of their score in 1<sup>st</sup> round, with 2<sup>nd</sup> phase timed for all those that were clear in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase.
- > A rider may substitute a Horse with permission from the Ground Jury **BUT** cannot change a RIDER.
- > Points awarded to Rider/Horse combination.
- Points will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> 10pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 8pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 7pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 6pts 5<sup>th</sup> 5pts, 6<sup>th</sup> 4pts 7<sup>th</sup> 3pts and 8<sup>th</sup> 2pts.
- > Horses must jump in the sequence as drawn per SJIlive. (This is for livestreaming)

- A separate league table will apply for the subgroup (6 Yr. olds) with the following points: 3 points for a double Clear round 2 points for one clear round and if faults in the first round you will get 1 point for appearance.

## Munster Region 1.15m Carleton Stables League 2024

- To be run as a Modified Two-Phase competition
- Only one Munster 1.15m Class in the Region on any one day
- Entry Fee €25.00
- Up the first horse entering the arena, you may move from the 115 to 125 and 125 to 115.
- Prize Fund: A Minimum of €300 at each leg of the league 1<sup>st</sup> €94, 2<sup>nd</sup> €63, 3<sup>rd</sup> €43, 4<sup>th</sup> €34,
- 5<sup>th</sup> €29, 6<sup>th</sup> €22
- Rider must be properly attired in correct Jacket (including in competition) & be present for Prize Giving (1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>) unless excused by the Ground Jury. (Failure will result in forfeiture of prize money.)
- Entries on SJI Live
- First round Entries to close at 4pm on the day before. Later entries up to 5pm with increase of €20.00 per entry.
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED after the 5pm Cut Off.
- All competitors will be entitled to two rounds irrelevant of their score in 1<sup>st</sup> round, with 2<sup>nd</sup> phase timed for all those that were clear in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase.

- We recommend you have four judges and one be of senior national level.
- League Table will be available on Facebook, Munster and SJI website.
- Venue for Final to be TBA.
- A cash bonus will be given to the best Three Five-year-olds in the class. Must jump 2 clear rounds.
- A separate league table will apply for the subgroup (5 Yr. olds) with the following points: 3 points
- for a double Clear round 2 points for one clear round and if faults in the first round you will 1 point
- for appearance

## Munster SJI will provide the following support if all requirements are met:

Fences cannot used for any class lower than 110.

Fences must be used for all 3 classes\*.

The Munster Summer Grand Prix fences will be dropped to the show in agreement with show secretary. The truck to be parked on its site for duration of the show. Show is responsible for unloading and build the track.

Shows are required to provide at least 3\* capable persons to help loading the fences after the show.

Rosettes will be provided and a Rug for the winner in each class.

Fences Components Lost or damaged will be charged back to the show.

Schedules must be in line with the Rules.

Provided there was full compliance with the above, Munster SJI will pay a grant of €1000.00 to the show. The following specific penalty will apply: -

Failure to use the Fences for all 3 classes on the same day in the correct order of 115> 125 >135. (40% Fine), or failure to provide at least 3 capable persons (20% Fine per Person) to load the fences after the show will result in a reduction in Support by 20% per non-Compliance. Maximum 100% Reduction.

The organising committee reserve the right to make changes should it be necessary.
